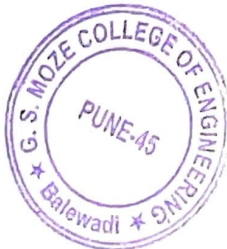

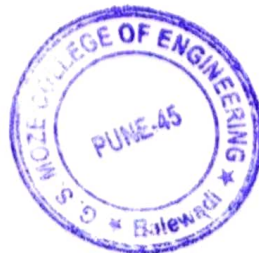

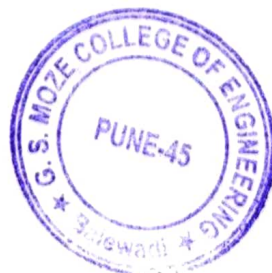
Report on Safety Usage of LPG


Genba Sopanrao Moze College of Engineering (GSMCOE), Balewadi College organized an informative workshop on 11th August 2018 at 4: 00 PM on the Safety Usage of LPG (Liquefied Petroleum Gas) in association with Gassafe India Ltd that has been working from past 20 years in the field of across the world. The workshop aimed to raise awareness about safe practices when handling LPG, especially in domestic settings. Participants gained valuable insights into LPG usage, accident prevention, and practical demonstrations.

The workshop agenda as below:

1. Understanding LPG- LPG Usage: LPG is commonly used for cooking, heating, and powering appliances in households. Properties of LPG: Participants learned about LPG's flammability, odorant (added for leak detection), and its heavier-than-air nature.
2. Accident Prevention- Safe Storage: Proper storage of LPG cylinders was emphasized. Cylinders should be kept upright, away from direct sunlight, and in well-ventilated areas. Leak Detection: Participants were educated on recognizing the distinct smell of LPG and the importance of promptly addressing leaks. Ventilation: Proper ventilation prevents gas buildup indoors, reducing the risk of explosions.
3. Domestic LPG Components- Regulator: The workshop covered the role of regulators in controlling gas flow from the cylinder to the stove. Proper installation and regular checks were emphasized. Pipes and Hoses: Participants learned about flexible hoses connecting the regulator to the stove. Regular inspection and replacement are crucial.
4. Live Demonstration- Handling LPG Safely: A live demonstration showcased safe practices when connecting and disconnecting LPG cylinders. Emergency Response: Participants learned how to shut off the gas supply during emergencies.

The demonstration to teaching and non- teaching staff were undertaken in the Seminar Hall, E Building. The workshop on Safety Usage of LPG provided essential knowledge to our college community. Some glimpses of the workshop below.

As a part of societal activity, civil engineering department has involved in carrying quality test of water which is being utilised by village people. The sample has been collected by Mr. Arun Sankpal & Mr. Vinayak B. Kulkarni (Faculties of the department), all standard tests have been performed by respective faculty member in Environmental Engineering laboratory of civil engineering department.

The various tests performed on collected sample are listed below:

1. Physical Parameters:

- Colour, Hazen units, Max
- Odour
- P^H value
- Taste
- Turbidity, NTU, Max


2. Chemical Parameters:

- Total dissolved solids, mg/l, Max
- Chloride (as Cl), mg/l, Max
- Magnesium (as Mg), mg/l, Max
- Nitrate (as NO_3), mg/l, Max
- Sulphate (as SO_4) mg/l, Max
- Total alkalinity as calcium carbonate, mg/l, Max
- Total hardness (as $CaCO_3$), mg/l, Max

All above test have been performed & compared with BIS standards, the values of all various tests are within permissible limit as per standard values.

The test report has been submitted to Mr. M. Bande (Sarpanch), Mr. Yuvraj (Upa-Sarpanch) & Gram Panchayat members in presence of village people.

Report On
Green Activity at Baner Hill's

Students participated: 42

Faculty members participated: 13

To contribute the beautiful work of Tree Plantation a programme was held by our college G. S. Moze College of Engineering, Balewadi, Pune and Vasundhara Abhiyan Baner on 12th Aug 2018, 7.00am at Baner Hills. The students of S.E, T.E, and B.E. from the department of Civil Engineering were actively participated in the programme. **Head of the department Prof. K Pramod along with all teaching and non teaching staff** were present for sapling as well as mulching for plants.

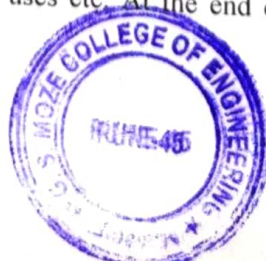
A small group of people joined hands in 2006 to plant saplings at Tukai hill, popularly known as Baner hill. More than a decade later Baner hills, to be named as Chandrakant Garudkar bio-diversity Park, has been developed into lush green cover

The hill was a cattle grazing ground for the villagers of Baner for years before development began. According to environmentalists, rapid urbanization and utilization of land for projects is the main reason for the depleting green cover. According to a survey, Pune district has lost 26 sqkm of forest cover since 2015 and this has put saving biodiversity on a priority with many environmentalists and environment groups.

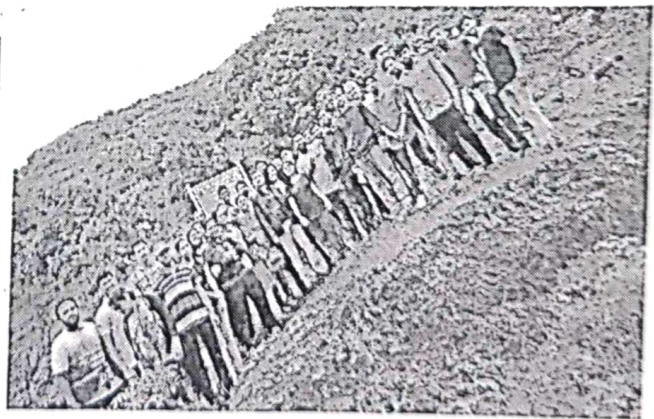
Dr Chandrakant Garudkar, a general physician who passed away in 2014, along with a few local residents began planting trees when he realised that the tree cover would slowly be lost in the upcoming development. Beginning slowly, the local group have covered survey no 7 and survey 49 (1) of hill with trees. The group has increased and has more than 700 volunteers covering 210 acres of hilly area from Baner to Pashan.

From the past 11 years, Dr Garudkar Vasundhara Abhiyan is working for biodiversity conservation and restoration of Baner hill with group meetings on Sundays for two hours.

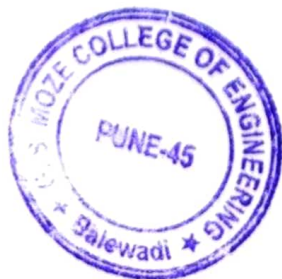
We had planted various types of plants some of them being Jacuranda (niligul mohar), Queen's flower, Queen's Crups, Indian laburnum, Copper pod (tamrashirebi), Mountain Ebony, Purpleorchid tree (kachanar), African Tulip tree, scarlet, fountain Tree (Pichakari), Rain tree and jurul tree. Our teachers had also explained about the trees and the importance of tree plantation. Even our help staff also taught us how to plant them and then they watered the plants. 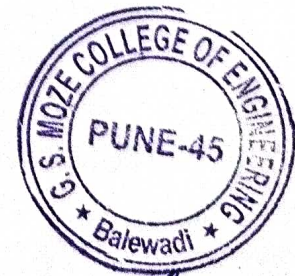
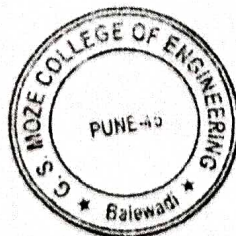
Summary

GenbaSopanraoMoze College of Engineering got a golden opportunity to visit an old age home, the SpandanVridh Ashram, on 26th November , 2018. The contingent, consisting of about 20 volunteers, reached Vadgaon at 11:00 A.M, looking forward to an amazing experience. The volunteers and the coordinators were welcomed warmly by the staff members of the old age home and the elderly themselves. The students interacted with the old age people in the ashram who shared their lifelong experiences with the volunteers and also talked about the social status of old people in the society. The students distributed the fruits and snacks among the old age people. The elderly people advised the students to give due respect to their parents as well as to their teachers. As the parents give birth and nurture children while the teachers help them to become educated citizens. The students also asked a number of questions from the old people who gave their reply to the students. Most of the elderly were suffering from Alzheimer's; seemed to be in great pain and just a few of them could interact with the contingent. The nostalgia of the good old days, marked by the absence of all the superficiality and _technology_ but boasting of the scintillating presence of humility and mutual respect stimulated all emotionally. Taking a trip down the spine, most of them had tears in their eyes, narrating the stories of their life. Nevertheless, the whole experience was emotionally satisfying and edifying. The volunteers endeavored to lift their spirits high by performing a song; all of which was highly appreciated and many elderly people joined in too. The volunteers also got a wonderful opportunity to interact with Mr.Bhagat, one of the founding members of the old age home. The volunteers were briefed that they had been maintaining two old age homes; one in Solapur and the other in Sangola. Most of the elderly who live in these old age homes are either rescued from the streets or procured through police/hospital authorities. Many of the times, they've rescued people who were left to perish by their own families, just because of their mental and physical illnesses. About the Program:

Gender equality, also known as sexual equality or equality of the sexes, is the state of equal ease of access to resources and opportunities regardless of gender, including economic participation and decision-making; and the state of valuing different behaviors, aspirations and needs equally, regardless of gender. Gender equality is the goal, while gender neutrality and gender equity are practices and ways of thinking that help in achieving the goal. Gender parity, which is used to measure gender balance in a given situation, can aid in achieving gender equality but is not the goal in and of itself. Gender equality is more than equal representation; it is strongly tied to women's rights, and often requires policy changes. As of 2017, the global movement for gender equality has not incorporated the proposition of genders besides women and men, or gender identities outside of the gender binary.

UNICEF says gender equality “means that women and men, and girls and boys, enjoy the same rights, resources, opportunities and protections. It does not require that girls and boys, or women and men, be the same, or that they be treated exactly alike. On a global scale, achieving gender equality also requires eliminating harmful practices against women and girls, including sex trafficking, femicide, wartime sexual violence, gender wage gap, and other oppression tactics. UNFPA stated that, “despite many international agreements affirming their human rights, women are still much more likely than men to be poor and illiterate. They have less access to property ownership, credit, training and employment. This partly stems from the archaic stereotypes of women being labelled as child-bearers and home makers, rather than the bread winners of the family. They are far less likely than men to be politically active and far more likely to be victims of domestic violence. As of 2017, gender equality is the fifth of seventeen
