#### Report on Time to Care About Your Health

On 07.09.2020, Genba Sopanrao Moze College of Engineering, Balewadi, in collaboration with the United Groups of Happy Friends (NGO), organized a webinar titled "Time to Care About Your Health." The focus of this event was to raise awareness about women's empowerment and well-being. In this report, we delve into the key takeaways from the webinar and highlight the importance of empowering women in various aspects of life.

The mental conditioning of Indian society has led to women having a very high threshold of patience and shence. Health of a woman is not a priority in our country. No one wants to invest in women's health. It works both ways because most of the time women also keep silent about their health issues. This was the core objective behind the webinar conducted.

Core areas focused during the webinar:

#### Fat Right:

Sometimes, medicine can cause you to gain weight. Other times, eating unhealthy foods can cause weight gain. Foods high in calories and saturated or "bad" fats can raise your blood pressure and cholesterol. This can becrease your chances of gaining weight and having other health problems, like heart disease and diabetes. Following points discussed:

- Don't skip meals. Eating consistently throughout the day provides your brain and body with a steady supply of fuel.
- Snack well. Sustain your energy by eating healthy snacks.
- Work on your balance. Your brain needs a healthy supply of carbohydrates, fats, and proteins, or it can't perform functions that affect your mood and thinking.
- Don't over-diet. Eat to be healthy and fit not to compare to anyone else.

Diet And Depression: Following points discussed under depression and diet:

- Vitamin B-12 and folate. Good sources of B-12 are fish like salmon and trout and breakfast cereals
  that indicate in the nutrition information that they are fortified. Folate is found in dark leafy
  vegetables, almonds, dairy products, and fortified whole-grain breakfast cereals. Examples of fortified
  food include milk, salt, and certain cereals such as Special K, Cheerios, Total, Wheaties, and Local
  Frosted Flakes.
- Omega-3 fatty acids. The best source of omega-3 fatty acids are fatty fish like salmon, catfish, and trout. Other sources include ground flaxseeds, walnuts, and egg yolks.



Key takeaways of the webinar:

- Hackers Are Patient and Persistent
  - -Hackers exhibit remarkable patience when attempting to breach systems. They tirelessly explore various avenues, trying out countless passwords until they succeed.
  - -Their persistence extends beyond a single day; they may continue their efforts over multiple days, undeterred by initial failures.
- Social Media Monitoring
  - -Hackers closely monitor individuals' social media accounts, seeking sensitive information such as pet names, birthdates, and anniversaries.
  - -This information is often used to create personalized phishing attacks or guess passwords.
- Beware of Unsuspecting Emails
  - -Email remains a vulnerable tool for hackers. They send seemingly harmless emails, requesting sensitive details like bank information.
  - -Always verify the legitimacy of such emails and avoid falling into their traps.
- Public Wi-Fi Risks
  - -Logging into public Wi-Fi networks exposes users to cyber-attacks. Hackers can manipulate data in real-time on unsecured networks.
  - -It's advisable to avoid public Wi-Fi whenever possible and use private, secure connections.

The "Webinar on Secrets Hackers Don't Want You to Know" served as an eye-opener for our college community. By implementing the recommended cybersecurity practices, we can collectively safeguard our digital lives and protect sensitive information. Total number of student and faculty participants were 57 through on-line mode.



"When something happens in your life, it is not the incident which is of much significance but the way how you respond to it." Genba Sopanrao Moze CoE Balewadi, organized, interactive session on Stress Management on 26th December, 2020, with great exuberance. The talk was spear headed by Mr.Atul, an eminent psychiatrist with specialisation in counselling psychology. Mr. Atul hails from reputed educational institutes such as the Delhi University. He was one of the founding team members of the Epsyclinic and has been its integral part since the very inception. Mr.Atul initiated the interaction by listing the deep rooted causes of stress: Exams' pressure, peer pressure, relationships and failures, and the fact that how an individual stands on thin ice when he's passing through these phases of life. She iterated the importance of mind relaxation through the practice of Yoga and Meditation. She also delivered a deeply engrossing talk on how many adolescents cannot cope with stress in their lives and ultimately commit suicide, and how it's an alarming situation for us. Mr. Atul, during the talk, also presented an Android application: "I will". The application basically seeks out to ascertain a person's mental health with the help of general questions. The attending volunteers were encouraged to download the application too. For the culmination of the session, Mr.Atul and the volunteers made valuable additions to the discussion that how stress needs to be dealt with more efficiency and how it is a wakeup call for acknowledging a person's mental health and stress levels. The exquisitely intriguing discussion proved to be of great benefit to the students. It added great depths to their understanding of psychological health and equipped them with a serene and revived positive outlook for life. After all, Stress is dangerous for your health, so have it in moderation like sweets, junks and cold drinks. All volunteer and coordinator had taken efforts for successfully completion of events.
