Visit Report - Orphanage Home – "Apna Ghar Ashram"

Wednesday, 11 January 2023; Student of Genba Sopanrao Moze College of Engineering, E&TC department, along with faculty members visited Apna Ghar Asharam an Orphanage in Hinjewadi, Pune. Apna Ghar Ashram is home for orphanage Physically Disabled women. 15 student volunteers from SE E&TC accompanied by Faculty Coordinators Prof. Sushma Patwardhan (HOD E&TC), Prof. Harshalata Mahajan, Prof. Sujata Girawale, Prof. Meegha Beedkar, Prof.Reena Asati, Prof. Shruti Regal in association with WILLPOWER Foundation visited the place.

Apna Ghar is the Ashram who provides hope for millions of homeless, helpless, destitute, oppressed, abandoned, mentally and physically sick, injured, infected adults and defenseless individual who struggle for their basic needs.

Apna Ghar Ashram is run by Mr. Rajheev Agarwal. At present 80 orphan Women between 26 to 90 age are living in Apna Ghar Ashram. They are accompanied with 2 Nurse for 24 hrs, 4 staff members along with 20 Housekeeping staff and caretaker. 2 doctors visit and check orphan women every Saturday and Sunday.

We reached the Orphanage at around 10:30 AM. The Womens of Apna Ghar Ashram were very excited to receive the members.

The Women of the orphanage were touched by the activity program conducted by the students of GSMCOE and Willpower foundation for them like Interactive Talk, Singing, Dance performance, and Group dance played with them to make the environment lively and lighter.

We also met the Manager and caretaker. While interacting with the caretaker, we got to know the history of the orphanage how it was established. We visited all the floors in Ashram and meet bed redden women's. Hygiene was maintained all over the ashram.

At the end we donated few Food Items (Rice ,Wheat, Poha, Rava, Groundnuts, Chips, Chikki, Biscuits etc)as a small contribution from E&TC Dept as a token of love

Visit Report- Road Safety

On the 10th of February 2023, the MBA students of Genba Sopanrao Moze College of Engineering (GSMCOE) participated in a CSR activity focused on Road Safety for Radha Chowk Junction near Balewadi, Orchids Hotel. This event was held near Radha Chowk, Pune, from 10:00 AM to 12:30 PM. The primary objective of the activity was to raise awareness about road safety measures and to reduce the number of accidents and injuries within the locality of Balewadi, near Radha Chowk, Pune.

The main purpose of the event was-

- To promote the consequences of road safety.
- \circ ~ To encourage responsible driving and pedestrian habits.
- \circ To collaborate with local traffic authorities to spread awareness effectively.

Radha Chowk was selected as the activity zone for the CSR initiative on road safety due to several key factors: High Traffic Volume: Radha Chowk is a bustling area with significant vehicular and pedestrian traffic, making it a critical point for road safety awareness.

10-12 students of MBA along with faculties assisted traffic officials around the Chowk area in managing the traffic flow, helping pedestrians cross roads safely, and ensuring that traffic rules were being followed. Participants distributed educational pamphlets and spoke to commuters about the significance of road safety measures. We reached the traffic junction near Radha Chowk, at around 10:15 AM. The traffic police were interacted for a duration of 30 minutes to understand the cause of the peak hour traffic at the chowk area irrespective of weekdays and weekends. Also, the location is central to the Hinjewadi office community, allowing for effective engagement with many residents and commuters. One important insight was highlighted during the interaction- the chowk is easily accessible for commuters travelling from Hinjewadi and towards the city so a major junction it was and management was highly important. The choice of Radha Chowk aligns with the objectives of promoting road safety and fostering responsible driving and pedestrian habits, making it an ideal location for this important social activity.

The team spent about 2.5 hours with commuters, public and helped the traffic control. 
- Sweeping and mopping floors, corridors, and common areas.
